

Someone who has been transformed by Jesus will seek to promote unity as opposed to someone who causes
Jesus wants us to be unified! He for it! (John 17:20-21) One of the greatest threats to unity is one another
1. WE SHOULD NOT JUDGE THOSE GOD HAS! "opinions" = not doctrinal issues where there is a clear right or wrong, but in secondary matters where the Bible does not give specific commandments. (v.1)
"despise" &"pass judgment" = are essentially synonymous — in both cases they are not building up unity but it by judging the other based on their own standards or convictions. (v.3) We must all remember that we are all at different in our walk with God. (v.2-3)(1 Corinthians 8:1-8)
Don't judge others based on standards or based on what God has led you to do! What may be a for you, may not be a sin for everyone! (v.4) (James 4:12)
Instead of letting these things cause division among us, we should because we love one another, seek to and build each other up! (Romans 14:19)
Paul tells us that in either situation, in what you eat or how you view the Sabbath, make sure you are doing it based on your
(v.5) (Colossians 2:16-17; Romans 14:23; 1 Corinthians 8:9-12)
Whatever God leads you to do regarding these issues, do it for Him and His with a clean conscience! (v.6)
We must always recognize Jesus' in our lives and in the lives of our fellow believers! (v.9)
Paul is saying why are you so focused on judging your brother when judgment is coming? (v.10-12) (2 Corinthians 5:10)
