

CBC – GOD NEVER FAILS (Romans 9:1-13) 01.14.18 Pastor Scott

In Chapters 9-11 Paul is dealing the nation of Israel and the that God made to them.
We know from the Old Testament that Israel was God's
people. (Deuteronomy 7:6; Jeremiah 31:33)
So, here's the problem that grieved Paul in the midst of His
celebratingif Israel was God's chosen people and Jesus came to save them (1:16), why did they Him?
Does this mean that God's to them has failed and if so, will His promises to us fail as well?
Paul was so distraught over the lostness of the Jewish people that he wished there was a way to his salvation and be cursed if it meant the Jewish people would be (v.1-5)
GOD NEVER FAILS! (v.6)
The Word of God has not, nor will it ever,!
We can completely it!
So, who are the true chosen ones? (The true Israel)
Paul gives us two illustrations to show us.
1. Through (Genesis 16-18) (v.7-9)
2. Through (Genesis 25) (v.10-13)
God's choice had nothing to do with they would do
or not do either good or bad.
In summary, we have seen today that
1. Being a true Israelite is the same thing as being a physical
Israelite.
So, God will keep all promises to His people, the true nation of Israel.
2. God will also keep His promises to those He today!
3. God chooses based on His prerogative, not on anything anybody
or does do!
