| First and foremost as believers we are citizens of! (Philippians 3:20) |

| Being a good citizen requires us to 1 GOVERNING AUTHORITIES! (v.1-5) (1 Peter 2:13-17) governing authority on every level was put in those places |
| of authority by God Himself! (John 19:10-11) |
| We are to submit to them whether we for them or not! |
| We are to submit to them whether we them or not! |
| We are to submit to them whether we like their or not! |
| We are to submit to them whether we approve of their |
| or not! (1 Timothy 2 :1-4) |
| Because God put the governing authorities in place and He commands us to submit to them – if we resist, we are |
| against God and we will be for it! |
| God uses governing authorities as a way to His people and to those who break the law. |
| The Holy Spirit that God has given each one of us as believers helps us submit to the governing authorities because the Spirit leads us to accomplish God's purposes for us! |
| Being a good citizen requires us to 2 OUR TAXES! (v.6-7) |
| Paying your taxes is – God commands we do it! (Matthew 22:21) |
| Are we to always to obey governing authorities w/o any exceptions?! There is and only exception! |
| The only time God allows us to resist those in governing authority is |
| when they require us to do something that God or |
| require us not to do something that God! |
| (Exodus 1:15-21; Daniel 3:8-30; Daniel 6:1-28; Acts 4:1-20; 5:17-29) |
