Luke 16:19-31

I. We Need a Conviction That Hell Is Real – Vss. 23-25.

There are several words the Bible uses to describe hell. First is Sheol, a Hebrew word as a general place for the dead and it had two compartments. Ez. 32:21.

Hades: the place of the unsaved dead. Lk. 16:23

Gehenna means destruction. Matt. 18:9

Asbestone means something that burns but is not consumed. This word is translated "unquenchable" in Mark 9:43&48

Tartarus and Abyssos, both mean abyss or bottomless pit. 2 Peter 2:4, Rev. 9:11

Pyr aionios which means everlasting fire. Matt. 25:41

Exōteros skotos which is outer darkness. Matt. 25:30
